Bug	MEDI-687	<p>OST - Titration dose quantity needs to be the initial dose of titration not final dose</p> <p>Resolution Initial titration dose, when scanned into prescription software, is showing the initial dose of the titration.</p>	NZ
Bug	MMCD-4	<p>Edit on chart removes pending stop</p> <p>Resolution On a charted line with a pending stop (a stop on a future date), when the line is edited, the pending stop remains the same on the medication.</p>	ALL
Bug	MMCD-3	<p>The correct facility IDs are not being displayed correctly in e-scripts</p> <p>Resolution Prescriber name and address are displaying correctly in e-scripts.</p>	NZ

Bug	MMCD-20	<p>Stop OST Medication should cancel the OST e-script</p> <p>Resolution When stopping an OST medication in the patient chart, e-script with the current medication gets cancelled.</p>	NZ
Bug	MMCD - 33	<p>OST - Date on individual script should be date it is generated - not backdated</p> <p>Resolution OST e-scripts are having date generated as today (the day it was generated) regardless of start date on script.</p>	NZ
Bug	MMCD-62	<p>OST – Scripts aren't being cancelled when cancel e-script button is pressed</p> <p>Resolution OST scripts if not scanned by dispensing software, can be cancelled if cancel button is pressed.</p>	NZ
Bug	MMTC-55	<p>If a patient is edited without changing their facility area, Notes record a new change under facility history</p> <p>Resolution When editing medication chart profile details no change will be recorded to the facility or area unless an actual change has taken place.</p>	All
